

Making Your Mobile Website Work Like An Android App

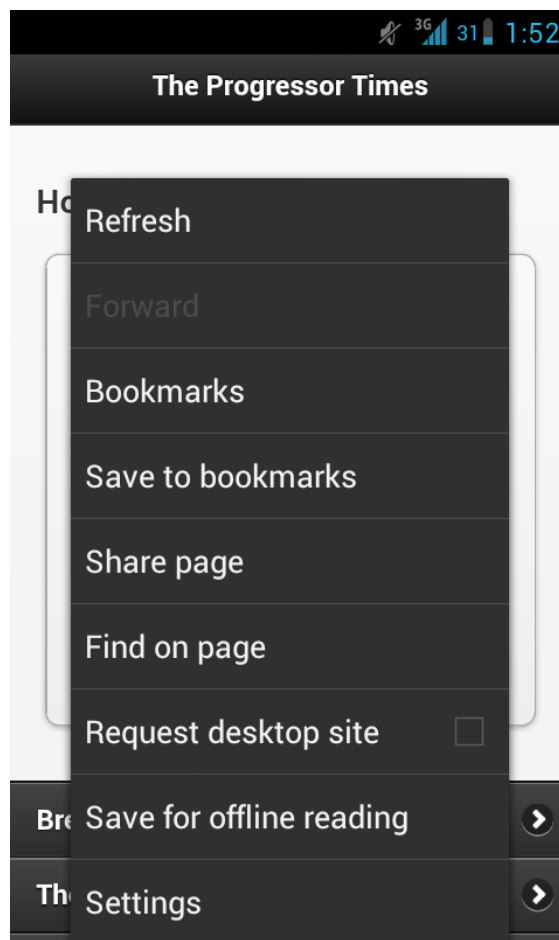

Step 1

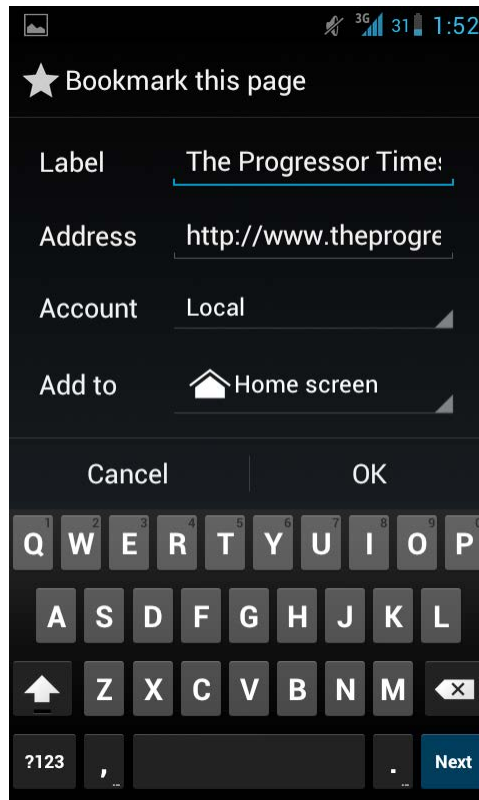
Start out on the home screen you want to add your bookmark/icon to. If you start out on a home screen that doesn't have room, it may give you a message that it can't be added to the selected home screen.

Step 2



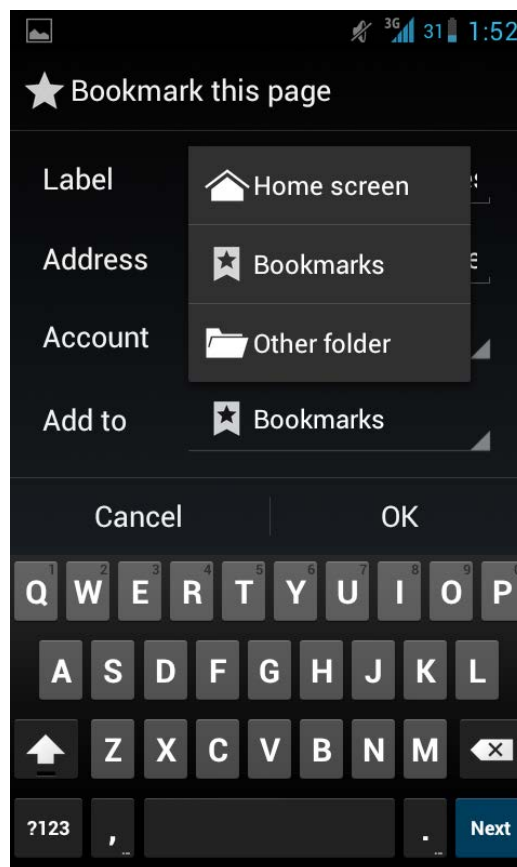
Open your mobile website in the browser, press menu button, choose "Save to bookmarks".

Step 3



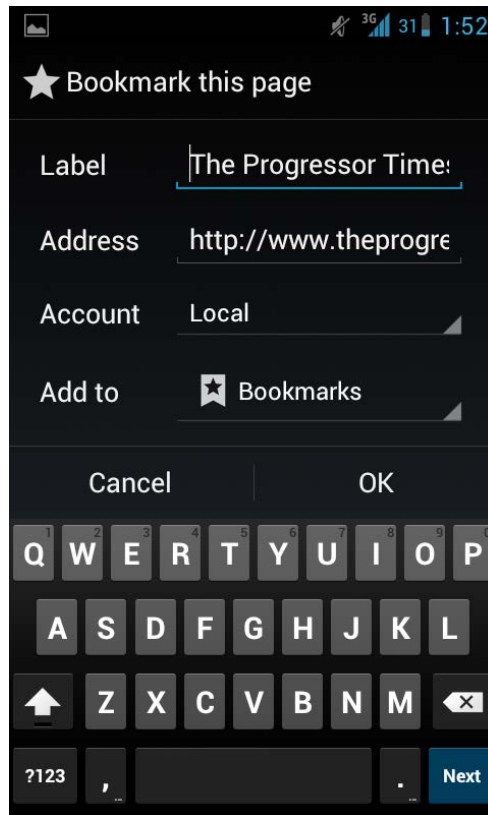
Edit the 'Label' with desired name for your bookmark/icon.

Step 4



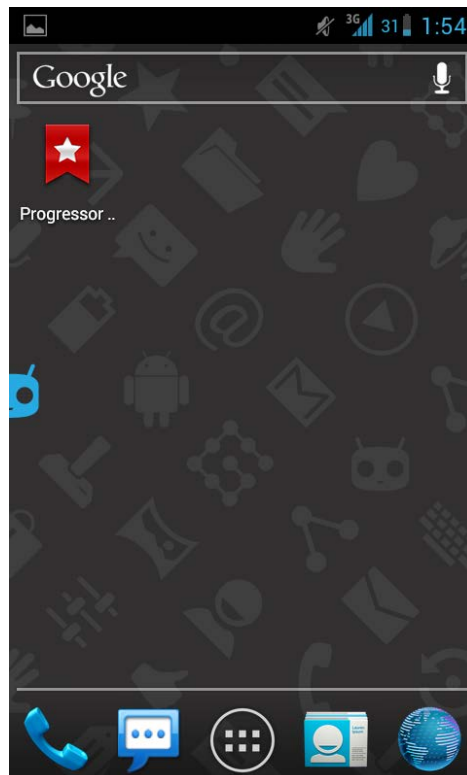
In the 'Add to' area, select "Home screen".

Step 5



Once you have the desired settings, press 'OK'.

Step 6



Bookmark/icon should show up like an app on your home screen and take you directly to the mobile website.
